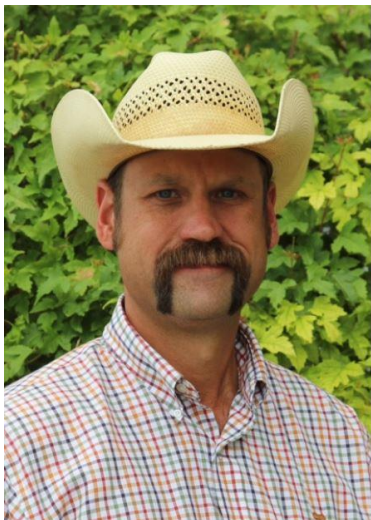
Area 8 Southeast: Johnnie Cundiff and Jim Yance **Region C:** Jeff Pettit
